We apologize for the error that occurred in the last issue of *African Journal of Medicine and Medical Sciences*. The third paragraph should have read:

Only men had significantly elevated haematoctrits. Reduction of a high normal haematoctrit is said to improve cerebral blood flow [4], as in the presence of a stenotic vessel wall platelet deposition is said to increase [20]. Smoking is also said to elevate the haematoctrit level [21] and advice against this may be beneficial. In this study patients with haematoctrits of 48 and over had regular venesection.
