## Notes for Contributors

All manuscripts should be addressed to the Editorial Office of the African Journal of Medicine and Medical Sciences, Postgraduate Institute for Medical Research and Training (PIMRAT), College of Medicine, University College Hospital, Ibadan, Nigeria.

Manuscripts are accepted subject to the understanding that no substantial part has been or will be published elsewhere. This does not refer to abstracts of oral communications that are printed in proceedings of societies or symposia.

Authors should send three complete copies of the manuscripts (maximum of 18 quarto-sized typed pages including bibliography, illustrations and tables) and retain one copy for reference. Apart from the three typescript copies on white bond paper, submission of a 3.5' diskette is required at acceptance stage. Authors should ensure that the diskette is clearly labelled with the paper title and name(s) of author(s). The diskette must be IBM compatible on Word Processing format up to version 6.1.

Manuscripts being submitted must be accompanied by a covering letter affirming that the paper is submitted only to this Journal. In the case of a paper with more than one author, all must sign the covering letter confirming that they participated sufficiently in the work.

A non-refundable processing fee of ₦800.00 per article will be charged authors who do not subscribe to the Journal while subscribers will pay ₦400.00 only. In addition, authors of papers submitted from Nigeria should send 4 large and 2 officials size envelopes with ₦300.00 worth of postage stamp for subsequent correspondence. The Editor does not accept responsibility for damage or loss of papers submitted.

Manuscripts, in English Language, should be submitted typed double-spaced and with at least 2.5 cm margins around.

On a single separate sheet, there must be the following: (a) title, (b) author's name and initials, (c) department/s in which the work was done, (d) the name and address of the author to whom correspondence should be addressed, (e) author's present address if different from the department/s in which the work was done, (f) if paper was presented at a meeting, please indicate name of organization, city month and year.

Titles should be short, specific and clear. Omit phrase such as "The use of," "observations on". Authors should provide a shorter running title and up to six keywords. Manuscripts must be accompanied by a summary not exceeding 200 words. The summary will be translated into French by the journal office at a cost to the author. Currently, the fee for translation is ₦500.00 non-refundable, which shall be forwarded by a bank draft to accompany the manuscript when found acceptable for publication. Figures and photographs must be submitted as glossy prints, untrimmed and unmounted. Each should be numbered with pencil lightly on the back with the top indicated. The numbers of photographs and illustrations should be kept to a minimum. The legends for figures and tables that should be numbered with Arabic numerals should appear on a separate page.

Publication of colour transparencies submitted must be paid for by the author at the time of acceptance.

All details on charts and graphs must be clearly legible when reduced to the size used in this journal.

The onus of preparing a paper in a suitable form for publication rests with the author. The need for editorial revision for badly prepared typescripts or diagrams may lead either to rejection of the article or delay in publication.

Authors should indicate by a statement their paper that they complied with requirements of the Ethics Committee of which the work was done. A Letter of approval must also accompany the manuscript submission. Where an Ethics Committee is available, the Helsinki Declaration principles should be followed strictly.

Workshop and conference reports should be 10 double-spaced quarto-sized pages. They could be papers expressing personal or political, socio-economic and other matters. The practice of medicine should be limited to typed pages. Letters to the Editor may be published in the Journal or clinic replies to comments, or other matters of relevance to medicine and related professions exceed 500 words with a few references and tables and figures.

This Journal has agreed to accept papers prepared in accordance with the Vancouver style. The Editor will consider only papers conforming to the Vancouver style.

References should be numbered in the order they are cited in the text. At the end of the list, references should be listed as numbered in the order they are cited. Each reference should give the names and initials (unless there are more than six, when only the first three should be given, followed by *et al.*). The year should be followed by the title of the article, (abbreviated according to the style of *Index Medicus*), the year of publication, the volume number and page numbers. Titles of books should be given in full, including publisher, place of publication, and year. The following are examples of references as follows:

Brown A. Primary Health Care and the Role of the Nurse. Edinburgh: Universities Press, 1983.

Lewis A. Primary liver cell carcinoma. In: *Primary Liver Cell Carcinoma*, eds. EL, eds. *Priorities in Health Planning*. London: University Press, 1983; 110 - 115.

Reference to tables should be given in the text, e.g. Table 3, and tables should include their meaning clear without reference to the text. Tables should be typed separately from the text.

Proof corrections are expensive. Only minor corrections of proofs other than printers' errors should be made. The minimum. Authors must return proof corrections within 10 days of receipt. Failure to do this will result in the article being published with the Editor's corrections. Manuscripts accepted for publication remain the property of the Journal.

Offprint may be ordered directly from the office of the Journal. This must be paid for at the time of final acceptance of paper.

Four journal pages will be printed at the discretion of the author. Extra pages will attract page-charge of ₦500.00 per page. (approximately 50% of the cost of a manuscript).
